

Hydrographic Society Russia



The 2nd Research-to-Practice Conference was held on the eve of the World Hydrography Day on 20 June 2014. It was run by the Hydrographic Society of Russia (HSR) in cooperation with the Department of Navigation and Oceanography of the Russian Federation Ministry of Defence (DNO of the RF MD). The theme of the conference was 'Hydrography - much more than just nautical charts. Research

works, innovations, technologies, challenges and prospects'.

Leaders and representatives of the Hydrographic Service of the Russian Federation Navy, leaders and employees of Russian companies focusing on Hydrography, representatives of educational institutions that train hydrographers, members of the Hydrographic Society and veterans took part in the conference. Professor N. Neronov, the president of the Hydrographic Society, and captain S. Travin, the head of the Department of Navigation and Oceanography welcomed the audience.

Many interesting reports were presented during the conference. These reports focused on the theory and practice of navigation, hydrographic support for different aspects of marine areas and professional training problems. Conference attendees discussed the reports and adopted the resolutions that were sent to the leaders of the relevant ministries.

There was a buffet reception at the end of the conference giving all the participants a chance to continue the exchange of ideas in a casual atmosphere.
