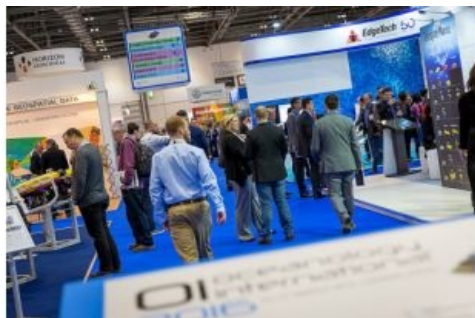


Oi18 in a Nutshell
