

Bob Hamilton Named as President of Woods Hole Group

Woods Hole Group, USA, has appointed Robert P. Hamilton Jr. (Bob) to president of the organisation, effective immediately. Dennis Aubrey, who served as president since 2001, has transitioned the office to Bob and will now serve as CEO.
