Decommissioning Contract with Hess

Subsea service company DOF Subsea UK has secured a contract with Hess to provide diver-less decommissioning services from its new multipurpose support vessel, the Skandi Skansen in the Ivanhoe / Rob Roy Field, North Sea. The project will last for approximately 21 days and is scheduled to start in Q3 2011 representing a revenue of approximately GBP5 million.

The scope of work includes a decommissioning program which involves the engineering and recovery of 4 mid water arches, 8 flexible risers and associated structures and umbilicals.
