

Exail strengthens Scandinavian presence with Norway office





Exail has opened a new office in Norway to support the company's growth in the Scandinavian region. Located in the Oslo area, the new office is led by Lars Sorfang, general manager for Exail AS and regional sales manager for Scandinavia. A former officer in the Norwegian military, Sorfang previously held various business development positions at Kongsberg, working on

strategic defence programmes, and Teledyne Flir, where he was sales director for the Europe region.
