Hydro12 Confirms Keynote Speakers

His current area of expertise is within marine geology, with emphasis on seabed sediments and morphology, links between geology and biology within an ecosystem framework, and applied aspects for ocean management.

Registration is now open and delegates are offered a discounted fee until 1 July 2012. When registering, it is also is possible to join the excursions on Friday 16 November 2012. They will take delegates to the Maasvlakte 2 land reclamation project working on extending the Port of Rotterdam, and the Sand Engine, which is a sophisticated sand supply project for the coast of The Netherlands. A partner programme is being prepared which promises to take delegates to other interesting places in Rotterdam and throughout The Netherlands.
