

Nautronix Appoint Chief Surveyor



Nautronix have appointed Sam Hanton as Chief Surveyor. Sam joins Nautronix after 10 years at Subsea 7 and its predecessors, latterly working as Senior Project Surveyor in both Norway and UK.
