European Distributors Required

OSIL has also announced that it is seeking distributors across Europe for the HydroCamel, a new Automated Submersible Water Sampler. Launched earlier in the year, the HydroCamel is capable of automatically collecting up to twenty samples per deployment (up to 3litres volume). The samples can then be used for ground truthing turbidity studies, general chemical or biological analysis. The HydroCamel can be deployed in depths of up to 70metres for a month at a time and is suitable for use in all water environments. OSIL is therefore looking for European distributors in sectors including freshwater, marine, wastewater and drinking water.
