

ROV Simulator Workshop During OI

The International Marine Contractors Association (IMCA, UK) is to hold a half-day workshop with the theme â€[−]The Diverse Role of the ROV Simulator' during Oceanology International on Wednesday 14th March 2012 at the ExCeL Conference & Exhibition Centre, London.
