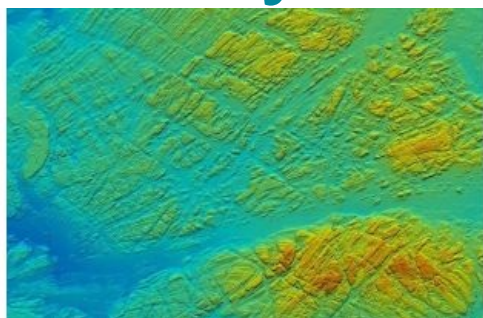


Three Days of In-depth Presentations During Shallow Survey 2015



The programme of Shallow Survey 2015, taking place from 14 to 18 September 2015 in Plymouth, UK, will according to its organisers provide three full days of highly informed and informative presentations promoting progress in seabed mapping in the coastal environment.
