

USGS Upgrades to SWATHplus

The US Geological Survey Center for Coastal and Marine Geology, located at Woods Hole, Massachusetts has recently taken delivery of a SEA SWATHplus, upgrade to the Submetrix 2000 system purchased in 2000. The centre will be using the SWATHplus for near-shore mapping and identification of seabed geo-morphology.

The SWATHplus electronics package is augmented with a much improved software suite that gives easier real-time control and processing, along with enhanced QC tools and 3D visualisation.
